

FUND OBJECTIVE

The Maybank Malaysia Balanced-I Fund ("MMBI" or "the Fund") is a balanced (shariah) fund that aims to attain a mix of regular income¹ stream and possible capital growth via investments into Shariah-compliant listed equities, Sukuk and other assets that are permissible under the Shariah Principles.

Any material change to the investment objective of the Fund would require Unit Holders' approval.

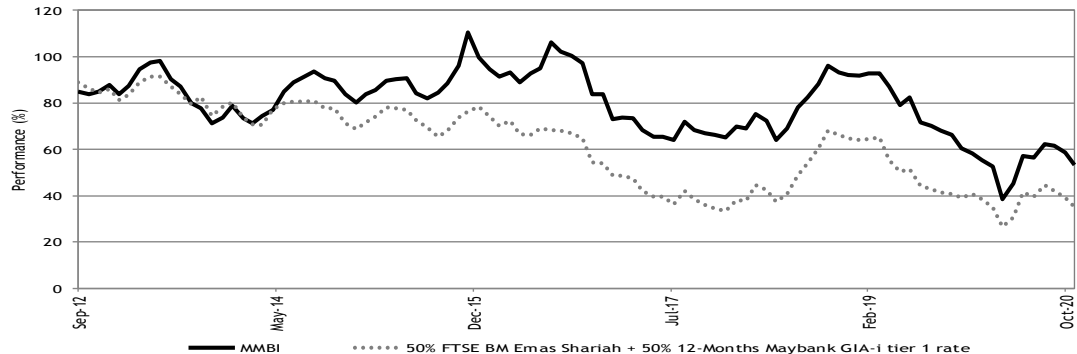

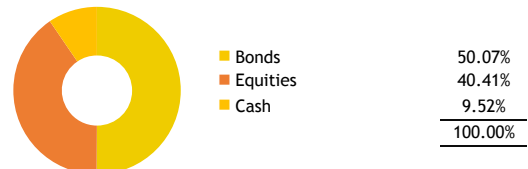

Based on the fund's portfolio returns as at 31 October 2020, the Volatility Factor (VF) for this fund is 8.38 and is classified as "Low". (Source: Lipper). "Low" includes funds with VF that are above 3.64 and less than or equal to 10.39 (source: Lipper). The VF means there is a possibility for the fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. The fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
