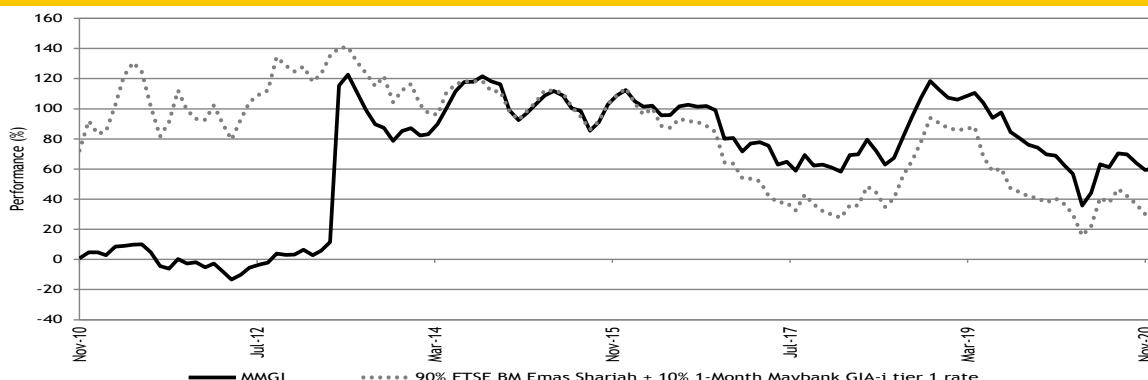

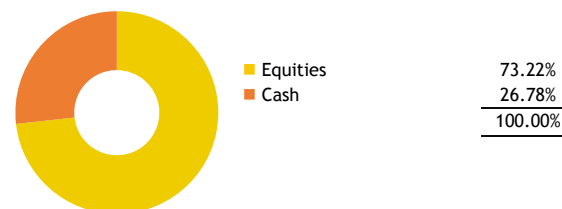

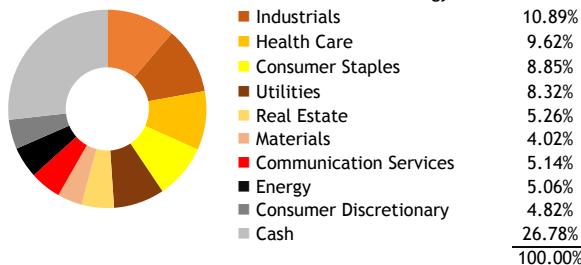

The yield of the distributions are calculated based on the total dividend payout/ex-distribution NAV.

Based on the fund's portfolio returns as at 30 November 2020, the Volatility Factor (VF) for this fund is 12.82 and is classified as "Moderate". (Source: Lipper). "Moderate" includes funds with VF that are above 10.375 and less than or equal to 13.94 (source: Lipper). The VF means there is a possibility for the fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. VF is subject to monthly revision and VC will be revised every six months. The fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guarantee that the fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.

This is a replacement Master Prospectus dated 17 January 2020 in respect of the funds that replaces and supercedes the Master Prospectus dated 1 November 2018 as amended by the First Supplementary Master Prospectus dated 18 October 2019 in respect of the funds.
